I must take this opportunity to thank the Local Board Members and senior staff of Auckland Council who made the restoration of the sea wall a reality. The process of consultation commenced in 2011 and we are extremely satisfied with the outcome.

In recognition of all the great work carried out by the Mahurangi East Fire Brigade the Committee, on behalf of the community of Algies Bay, made a donation of \$500 to assist with the installation of lights for the Helicopter Pad at Snells Beach.

The annual cleanup of the beach was very well attended with more than 60 folk giving up their Saturday morning. Special thanks to Dave Cammell for taking the lead roll again and also to Nigel for rallying the troops via email, it was a shame that we then had some rather inclement weather recently which bought great deal of debris to the beach.

Just a gentle reminder that the liquor ban applies from 9pm each evening to 6am on the following day, from 24 December until the end of daylight saving.

Please remember that there is no parking permitted on Boat Ramps and that there is a 5 knot speed restriction in operation.

A word of advice to all Boaties coming into the boat ramp over the holidays.....expect regular but ad hoc inspections of your fishing catches by the Ministry of Primary Industries.
