Below is a tasty Recipe for the lucky ones.

TASTY SAVOURY SCHNITZEL

Roll up each piece of meat, partly frozen is easier, but not absolutely necessary.

Cut approx. 500gms of schnitzel into strips.

Place in bowl.

Add 1 tspn sugar

2 tbspn Soya Sauce

1 tbspn Worcestershire Sauce,

1 tbspn Oil (Sesame Oil is good)

Salt & Pepper

Stir

Sprinkle ¼ cup Cornflour over this.

Heat 1 tbspn Oil in Saucepan (Sesame Oil is good)

Add meat mixture. Stir all the time to prevent sticking (using a wooden spoon is best).

You need to add ¼ cup water almost immediately to help prevent sticking and keep adding water all the time until mixture is nice and rich and thick.

You will probably need to add at least 250mls altogether.

Simmer until tender, approx. 40 mins.

I simmer mine for more as it makes a nice smooth rich gravy with extra cooking.

You can add bacon, mushrooms, frozen peas if you wish as this makes it extra nice, but alright on it's own if you haven't.

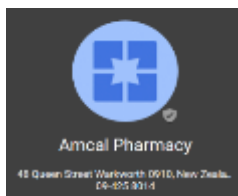
