NO BYO please.

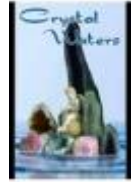
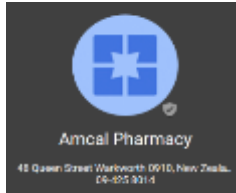
